

STRING TELEPHONES

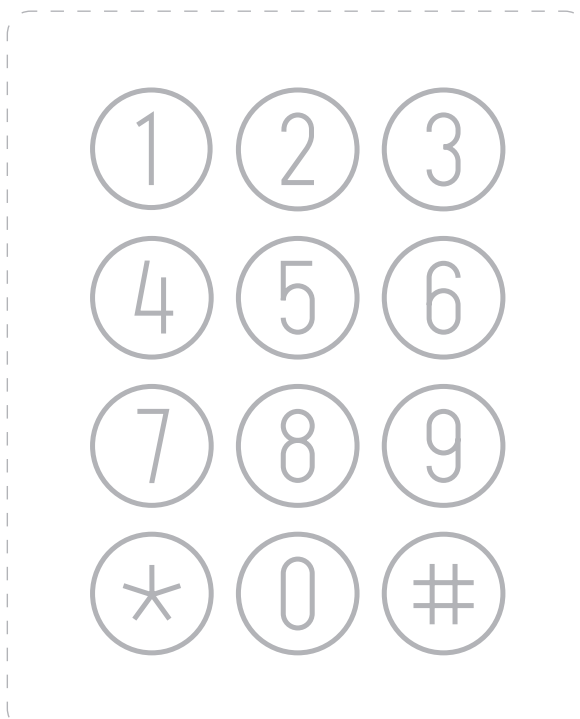
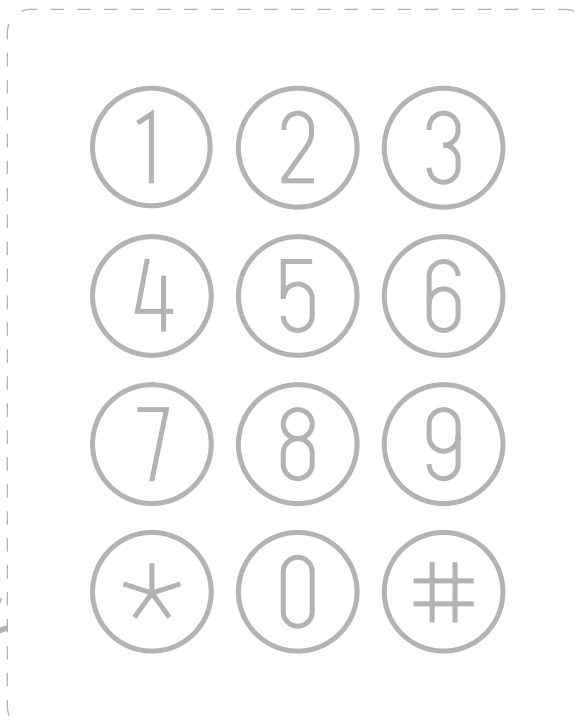
Technology and Art Activity!

What you'll need:

- Staedtler jumbo coloured pencils
- Staedtler scissors
- Staedtler glue stick
- Paper cups
- String
- A printout of the supplied worksheet

Method:

1. Instruct the class to cut-out and colour their telephone templates, decorating them in a bright and colourful way.
2. Give 2 cups to each student.
NOTE: You will need to place a hole in the bottom of each cup before handing out.
3. Guide the class to paste their telephone templates onto their paper cups, using the **Staedtler glue stick**.
4. Using **Staedtler scissors** cut the telephone string to a desired length and hand out to each student. Instruct and help students to thread the string through the cup holes and tie a knot on the inside and outside of both cups.
5. Encourage students to pair up with a classmate and test their string telephones. Guide a classroom discussion around when, where, how or why students felt their phone worked/didn't work.
