CREATE YOUR OWN PHARAOH'S MASK

Art and History Activity!

Creating an Egyptian scene with a pyramid and treasures hidden in sand!



Step 1

Roll out a quarter of a block of FIMOair light white until approx. 1cm thick. Cut around a lid using a plastic knife to make a circle shape approx. 10cm diameter. Mark circles in the middle using smaller lids or cardboard tubes (circles form part of mask decoration). Leave to air dry thoroughly.



Step 2

Roll out a quarter of a block of **FIMOair light** white into an egg shape. Flatten the back and smooth the top surface for the face. Mark decorative lines across the top using a plastic knife.



Step 3

Roll a quarter of a block of **FIMOair light** white until approx. 1cm deep. Cut out two matching shapes to fit on either side of the face, decorate with lines and press into position. Add features for the face, more decoration including a snake, and leave to air dry thoroughly.



Step 4

Glue the mask on to the circle shape and allow to dry before painting e.g. with metallic acrylic colours. If any of the pieces are loose after drying, stick them in position with glue.



What You Need:

- ✓ FIMOair light: White
- ✓ Roller
- ✓ Lid (approx. 10cm diameter)
- ✓ Plastic knife or modelling tool
- ✓ Cardboard tubes
- Acrylic paints
- ✓ Brushes
- Glue
