

## **DIY Satisfying Sand**



Warning: Choking Hazard - Small Parts. Not for children under 3

years. Adult supervision is required. Do not eat or drink. Thoroughly wash hands before and after making and playing with slime. **Supplies** 

## · Elmer's 4 oz White School Glue

- Elmer's 8.75 oz Magical Liquid
- 1 tbsp of water
- Small bowl
- Fine art or play sand (about 2 pounds)
- Shaving cream
- Bowl and spatula for mixing
- Measuring spoon (tbsp)



## Combine 1 tbsp of Elmer's White School Glue with 1 tbsp of

shaving cream in your small bowl.



stick to your fingers.

meaning it will come together and not stick to the bowl, but will still



reactivate the jiggly slime.



Add the sand a little bit at a time - about enough to just cover the top of your slime in your bowl. Thoroughly press and knead the sand into your slime until it's completely mixed in.



Once your slime no longer feels like slime, and is stretchy, soft, gritty, spreadable, and moldable, you've sufficiently turned it into a Satisfying Sand! Have fun playing!
