"Recycle Mate is a national recycling education initiative working to remove the guesswork in recycling, no matter where you are in Australia. The free Recycle Mate app has been designed with cutting-edge artificial intelligence technology and Australia's most comprehensive recycling database – right at your fingertips.

"The program is community driven so the more people get involved, the better it gets for everyone. Our partnership with Officeworks is working to enhance community awareness about the opportunity to return old items to Officeworks stores and direct them to their nearest options in one easy step - helping to prevent valuable materials from ending up in landfill."

Officeworks' People and Planet Positive commitments outlines 18 ambitious commitments across six pillars, providing a five-year roadmap for its team, partners, and communities to work towards. Officeworks also offers a device trade-in program, providing consumers with the option to replace their old phones, tablets, laptops or smartwatches with something new ahead of the Black Friday and Christmas sales period. In partnership with Moorup, an Australian B-Corp certified technology company whose mission is to extend the lives of electronic devices, the trade-in program helps save Australians money just in time for Black Friday, while also helping the planet.
