

# How To Make an Easter Bunny Party Hat



## WHAT YOU WILL NEED

- Quill A3 Board White
- Quill A4 210gsm Board Pastel Assorted 25 Pack
- Studymate Soft Grip Scissors 6"/152mm
- Keji Clear Adhesive Tape with Dispenser 18mm x 25m 2 Pack
- Little Learner Chenille Sticks White 100 Pack
- Little Learner Elastic White 4m
- Studymate Glue Stick 35g
- Keji Coloured Markers 12 Pack
- Kadink Googly Eyes Black and White 125 Pack



**STEP 1** Cut a wide triangle with a rounded base from white cardboard. Overlap the two straight edges together to form a cone. Fasten with sticky tape.




**STEP 2** Using pink cardboard, cut out two ears and a nose. Fix the ears to the back of the cone with tape, and attach the nose with a glue stick.



**STEP 3** Attach a pair of googly eyes with glue. Draw on eyelashes and a mouth with black pencil.



**STEP 4** Cut a chenille stem (pipe cleaner) to create whiskers.



**STEP 5** Using a plastic kids' needle, make holes on either side of the bunny's nose. Push the pipe cleaner pieces through the holes then bend on the inside of the cone to secure in place.



**STEP 6** Using the needle, make a hole on each side of the hat, and thread elastic through to make a chinstrap.

# How To Make a Paper Flower Crown




## WHAT YOU WILL NEED


- Kadink Construction Paper A4 Assorted 500 Pack
- Kadink Chenille Stems Assorted 40 Pack
- Studymate Soft Grip Scissors 6"/152mm
- Keji Mini Stapler Black
- J.Burrows Double-sided Tape with Dispenser 12mm x 25m
- Keji Clear Adhesive Tape with Dispenser 18mm x 25m 2 Pack




**STEP 1** Join two pieces of pipe cleaner together into a large circle.




**STEP 2** Cut a strip of white paper and a narrower strip of yellow. Lay the yellow paper on top of the white. Keeping the two strips together, make small folds, back and forth, to form a concertina.



**STEP 3** Fold the concertina in half, then staple the two middle edges together to form a fan.



**STEP 4** Repeat steps 2 & 3 to create the other half of the flower. Staple the two fans together to create a full pinwheel. Repeat again to make another, smaller flower.



**STEP 5** Thread a small length of yellow pipe cleaner through the middle of each flower and twist the ends around the large circle headband.



**STEP 6** Cut some leaves from green cardboard and tape to the back of the flowers.

# How To Make a Glitter Foam Garden



## WHAT YOU WILL NEED

- Quill A2 210gsm Board Green
- Kadink A4 Glitter Foam Sheets Assorted 8 Pack
- acky Craft Glue 125mL
- Studymate Soft Grip Scissors 6"/152mm
- Kadink Googly Eyes Black and White 125 Pack
- Keji Clear Adhesive Tape with Dispenser 18mm x 25m 2 Pack



**STEP 1** Cut a long strip of green cardboard to create a headband, then cut green glitter foam with jagged triangles to form sparkly grass.



**STEP 2** Use pink glitter foam to cut a bunny face and bunny ears. Cut a semicircle from gold glitter foam to make a chick. For beginners, draw shapes on the back before cutting.



**STEP 3** Cut a bunny nose from dark pink glitter foam, and the chick's beak from red glitter foam. Need help with the circle? Trace around a five cent piece.



**STEP 4** Use craft glue to attach the nose and beak, and add a pair of googly eyes to each.



**STEP 5** Stick the bunny, chick, and grass to the cardboard with craft glue. Dry for at least two hours.



**STEP 6** Wrap the headband around their head, trim any excess cardboard, and fix in place with sticky tape.

# How To Make a Cute Carrot Hat



## WHAT YOU WILL NEED


- Kadink Construction Paper A4 Assorted 500 Pack
- Quill 230gsm Fluoro Board Orange 510 x 635mm
- Studymate Soft Grip Scissors 6"/152mm
- Little Learner Elastic White 4m
- Keji Coloured Markers 12 Pack
- Keji Clear Adhesive Tape with Dispenser 18mm x 25m 2 Pack
- Educational Colours Plastic Needles 32 Pack



**STEP 1** Cut a wide triangle with a rounded base from orange cardboard. Overlap the two straight edges to form a cone. Fasten with sticky tape.




**STEP 2** Draw lines of different lengths around the cone to create a carrot-like appearance.



**STEP 3** On a strip of green paper, cut in long triangle shapes or 'fronds'. Make two strips of fronds to fit around the inside edge of the cone.



**STEP 4** Attach the fronds to the cone with tape.



**STEP 5** Splay the fronds outwards by pressing the hat down on a table.



**STEP 6** Using a kids' plastic needle, make a hole on each side of the hat and thread elastic through to make a chinstrap.
