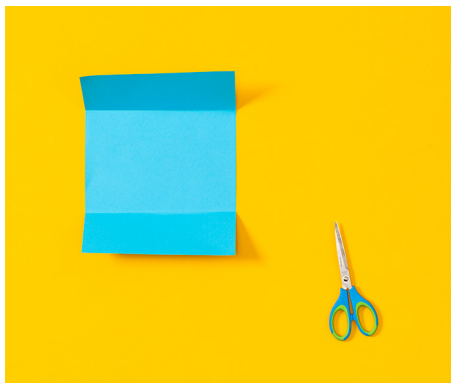


How to Make a DIY Father's Day Card



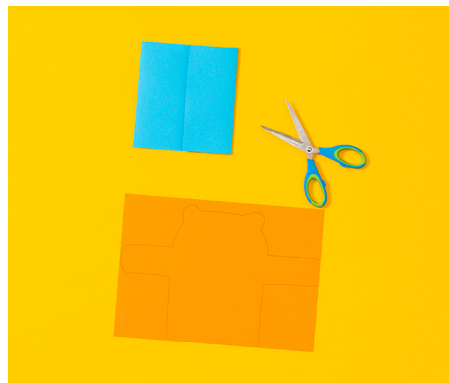
WHAT YOU WILL NEED

- Kadink Construction Paper A4 Assorted 500 Pack
- Sharpie Fine Permanent Markers Electro Pop 24 Pack
- Uni POSCA PC 5M Paint Marker Assorted 8 Pack
- Studymate Glue Stick 21g
- Studymate Soft Grip Scissors 6"/152mm
- Studymate Coloured Markers 12 Pack



STEP 1

Fold a piece of A4 paper so the sides meet, making 'doors'. Trim a few centimetres off the top so the bear's head can pop out of the top of the card.



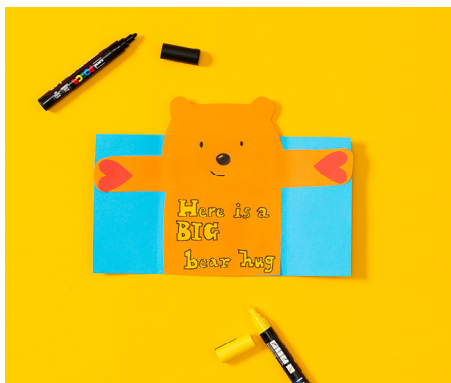
STEP 2

Cut out a bear shape, with open arms and a head that will peek out the top. Then write a message on the bear's tummy like, "Here's a big bear hug!"



STEP 3

Cut out heart shaped pads and glue onto the bear's paws. For a heart that is even, fold your paper in half and cut half a heart next to the fold.



STEP 4

Note how much of the bear's head peeks out above the doors. Add the eyes, nose and mouth, keeping them hidden behind the doors for a surprise.



STEP 5

Cut out a rectangle and write 'Dear Dad' on it, then snip it in half, and attach each half to the front sides of the card.



STEP 6

Open the card back up to make sure everything is in place, then write a Father's Day message inside, before closing and popping it onto his present.

How to draw the bear in your card

STEP 1

Draw your bear a body, do this in pencil and softly.



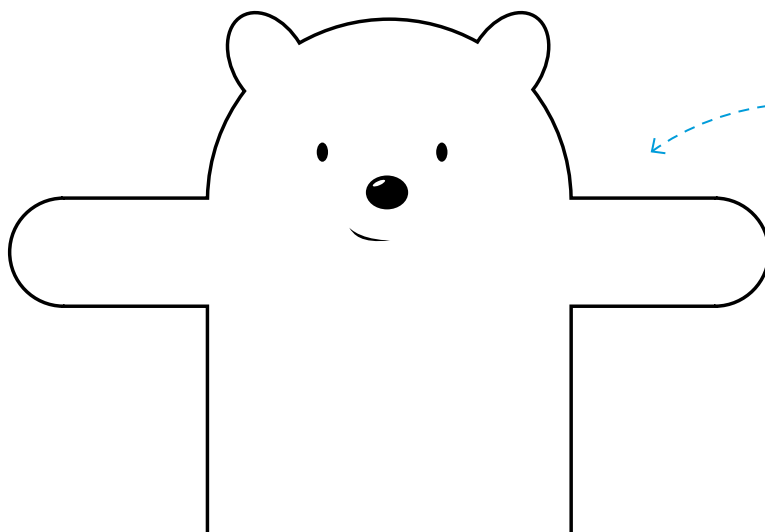
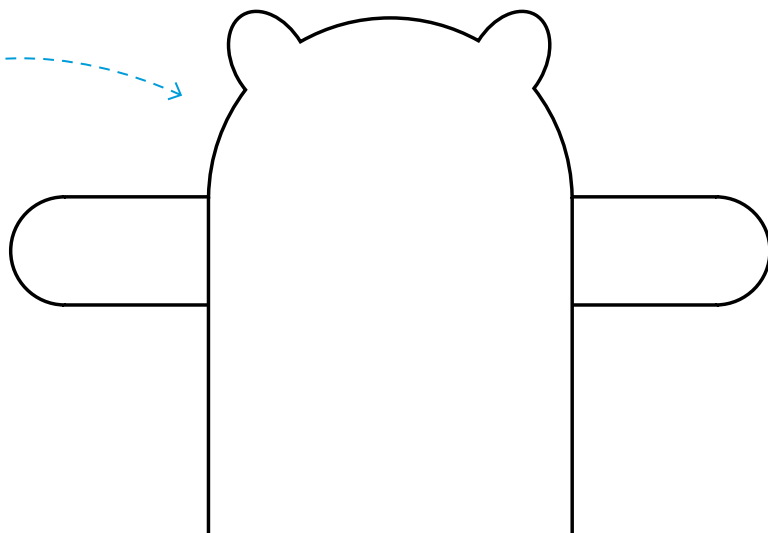
STEP 2

Give your bear some ears.



STEP 3

Reach out! Make his arms stretch out for a big bear hug.



STEP 4

Give him a face.
The cuter the better!
